This indemnification shall be in force while in transit to, at the show site and on surrounding grounds.

Each exhibitor will be assigned a roughly 10x10 space upon check-in. Each exhibitor must provide his or her own tent and all items necessary for it to be securely erected and fastened. Electricity is NOT available.

There is NO PARKING available on the show grounds. An area nearby will be reserved for exhibitor vehicles. ALL vehicles MUST BE REMOVED from the show grounds after unloading and NO LATER THAN 9AM. Volunteers will be available to assist with efficient unloading and moving of vehicles as necessary.
